Parking: Free parking is available in the Airport's Main Parking Garage, Short Term Parking. Park in any available space and proceed to the Main Terminal. Proceed to the Ticketing Level (upper level) and enter the A concourse security checkpoint. There will be a welcome table as you enter the checkpoint where you will obtain security clearance and a parking voucher.

Initial Welcome and Briefing: Hopkins Airport Commissioner Fred Szabo will conduct a briefing regarding Airport Security in the Hopkins Room, which also serves as the Airport Emergency Operations Center. The Hopkins Room is in the corner at the south end (entrance) of Concourse A, straight ahead as one exits the Concourse A security checkpoint, or a hard left at the top of the ramp from the main lobby of the terminal to Concourse A.

Presentations: There will be two presentations of Airport Security operations designed to familiarize the participants with significant components of airport security:

· **Cleveland Police Canine Unit/Bomb Unit Demonstration:** The Cleveland Police Department supports three full time TSA/FAA certified canine teams at Hopkins Airport. These canine units are trained in the detection of explosive devices in a crowded and chaotic environment. The CPD Bomb Unit has a field office at Hopkins Airport and responds to and mitigates calls of suspected explosive devices in the Terminal or aboard commercial aircraft.

· **Transportation Security Administration Behavioral Detection Unit Briefing:** The Transportation Security Administration is responsible for passenger and baggage screening at commercial airports. One of the most recent and effective strategies employed to address potential terrorism activities is the deployment of trained Behavior Detection personnel throughout the airport. These units study behavioral characteristics of passengers and employ tactics designed to identify and neutralize potential threats.
